Meganne Brenon attended summer music camps as a teen and while she enjoyed them, she never experienced anything like Luzerne Music Center.

As a first-year camp counselor in 2019, Meganne wasn't sure what she would find at the charming camp on the shores of Lake Luzerne.

"I have no idea what I was expecting, but Luzerne Music Center totally blew it away," she said. "It was a life-changing experience I wouldn't give up for the world."

The 20-year-old flutist is heading into her senior year at SUNY Fredonia, studying music education, so she's no stranger to working with children or being around music. But LMC still managed to surprise her.
